Notes

- 1 Defaults or Walkovers are recorded as 1-0 in matches and 2-0 in sets for the winning team.
- 2 Super Tie-breakers in the 3rd set are shown as 7-6 (10-x), with the winning team awarded 1-0 in matches, 2-1 in sets. Game scores for the third set will total 13, whether a full set and a 7 point tie-breaker was played or whether just a 10 point tie-breaker was played, to allow for consistency (from previous years).
- 3 Weekly (interim) standings will be based on highest total match wins (only relevant if all teams have not played the same number of times). Final standings will be based on highest match percentages, then set percentages if the match percentages are the same. If match and set percentages are the same, then the game percentage will be the deciding factor. Points (2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss) are only for informational purposes.
